- Develop and implement stewardship strategies for donors at all levels, with a focus on mid-level and major donors.
- Create and manage timely and meaningful donor communications (impact reports, thank-you letters, personalized updates).

- Collaborate with program teams to gather stories and impact data for donor reporting.

- Familiarity with fundraising best practices and donor privacy standards is an asset
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills, including brief writing.

- Ability to work independently and collaboratively in a mission-driven environment.
- Experience working with volunteers in a nonprofit setting is an asset
- CFRE certification or working toward it is an asset.
